A Timber Harvest Plan (THP) in the Bucks Lake area on PG&E lands will be submitted to CALFIRE in the near future. Property leased by you has been identified as being within 1000 feet downstream of this proposed project area.

Locations of Project: Haskins Valley and Bucks Lake Quadrangles
Portions of Sections 3 and 10 of T23N, R7E, MDBM.

In accordance with 14CCR Section 1032.10, we are requesting any information that you may have regarding the existence of any **SURFACE** domestic water supplies obtained from springs, creeks, canals, lakes or other surface supplies (Class I, II and IV watercourses) that receive drainage from the THP area. The particular watercourses which may be affected by this project are Bucks Lake and unnamed tributaries. If you have any information about surface domestic water usage from these watercourses, please contact me at 530-598-6734 within 10 days of receipt of this notice or mail comments to:


